Poverty is a social determinant of health



Social determinants of health are social and economic factors that influence health; they represent the conditions in which people are born, grow, work, live, and age. Poverty is an important social determinant of health. Living in poverty drastically affects health outcomes and has a disproportionately negative impact on vulnerable populations. This document provides data on **the percentage of individuals and families living below the federal poverty level** for all cities and towns in Massachusetts.

How do we assess poverty rates?



Information on individuals and families living below the federal poverty level is collected through the American Community Survey (ACS), run by the US Census Bureau. The data tables in this document show the percentages of individual and families living below the poverty level in each Massachusetts cities and towns. In 2017, the federal poverty level for an individual was \$12,060; for a family of 4, the poverty level was \$24,600. The data in this document is based on the most recently available ACS data (2013-2017 estimates).
